The purpose of this meeting is to review your summer activities and be sure that you are on track to complete the CAS requirements on time for graduation.

Note: There is only one formal interview this year, at the conclusion of the program so this meeting is important.

To prepare, you should plan to discuss the following:

1. **Summer projects.** If you participated in any activities during the summer that count for CAS, be sure that you have uploaded reflections and supervisor reviews and be prepared to talk about those projects and what you learned.
2. **Evaluate balance between Creativity, Activity and Service.** Are there specific areas in which you need to increase your engagement this year?
3. **Gaps** Which L.O.'s do you need to focus on this year, and what is your plan for addressing them?
4. **Plans to continue** Which project(s) do you plan to continue this year? Which new projects to you plan to start?
5. **Legacy project ideas** Which projects that you have done should become legacy projects? Who have you identified in the current Year 12 that is interested and reliable enough that you can train them to take over next year?

There is no interview rubric for this meeting, but your advisor will ask you to make a note on Managebac about the results of the meeting and your current status toward completion.

Note: Should there be concerns that need to be addressed, your advisor or the coordinator may ask you to have additional meetings as necessary, but you are always free to talk with your advisor or the CAS coordinator at any time.
